Stop Ask First! (7 minute DVD)—An animated video about poison prevention for young children (ages 3-6 years) showing situations where children should ask before touching, tasting or smelling.

Spike's Poison Prevention Adventure (11 minute VHS and DVD)—Puppet show with a classroom of children that introduces poisonous products and/or things in our homes in a fun and entertaining way. This video is educational and entertaining for pre-school children.

Poison Adventure (20 minute DVD)—Children learn about things that are poisonous from the Poison Patrol “through the magic of video” in this educational and humorous video. Appropriate for elementary school aged children.

Middle School- Adult

Stolen Dreams: The Reality of Ecstasy (15 minute VHS) – Gives Maryland youth the opportunity to speak out about the impact of their decisions to use or not to use on their lives and futures. It is designed to educate middle school students about the physical, psychological, and social effects of ecstasy use and to encourage the development of effective decision-making skills.

Educate: Creating Inhalant Abuse Awareness (15 minute VHS) - Discusses several types of inhalants and warning signals that may point to possible inhalant abuse.

Children and Poisons: What You Need To Know (23 minute VHS and DVD) – Aimed at adult caregivers of young children. Take a tour of a home to find the poisons found in every day life and listed to the Medical Director from the poison center explain their dangers.

Unintentional Poisoning: Prevent, React (13 minute VHS and DVD) – Aimed at caregivers of young children. Animated video discusses preventing poisonings and the steps to take for poisons that are ingested, inhaled, on the skin or in the eye. Available in English and Spanish, Cantonese, Mandarin.
